

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Aniban II, Bacoor City, Cavite as of 08 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 February 2024 at around 1:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Aniban II, Bacoor City, Cavite. The fire spread quickly through the houses made of light materials. It was declared fire out at around 2:57 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **36 families** or **147 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Aniban II, Bacoor City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **27 families** or **108 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Aniban Covered Court** in **Brgy. Aniban II, Bacoor City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **39 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **36 families** or **147 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Aniban II, Bacoor City** (see Annex D).

08 February 2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DSWD FO CALABARZON maintains close coordination with the LGU of Bacoor City through its City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation. • The Rapid Assessment Team of DSWD FO CALABARZON Provincial Quick Response Team (QRT) in Cavite was advised to be on standby for possible deployment. • DSWD FO CALABARZON advised the CSWDO and City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) of the LGU of Bacoor City to ensure the provision of assistance from private sector and civil society organizations are monitored and tracked to avoid duplication of assistance to affected families and individuals. • The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) of DSWD FO CALABARZON is placed on alert status to continuously monitor updates on the situation of the affected families and individuals.
