#### I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 2:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Anuling, Patikul, Sulu. The fire was declared out at around 3:45 PM.

A total of 53 families or 265 persons are affected in Brgy. Anuling, Patikul, Sulu (see Annex A).

A total of **53 families** or **265 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

A total of 41 houses were damaged; of which, 31 are totally damaged and 10 are partially damaged in Brgy. Anuling, Patikul, Sulu (see Annex C).
