

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Anuling, Patikul, Sulu as of 22 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 2:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Anuling, Patikul, Sulu. The fire was declared out at around 3:45 PM.

A total of **53 families** or **265 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Anuling, Patikul, Sulu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

A total of **53 families** or **265 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **41 houses** were damaged; of which, **31** are **totally damaged** and **10** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Anuling, Patikul, Sulu** (see Annex C).
