### I. Situation Overview

On 23 January 2024 at around 5:27 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bogasong, Libagon, Southern Leyte.

**One (1) family** or **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bogasong, Libagon, Southern Leyte** (see Annex A).

#### Inside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **six (6) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Bogasong Hall** in **Libagon, Southern Leyte** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Bogasong, Libagon, Southern Leyte** (see Annex D).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱52,568.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱17,861.50** from **DSWD** and **₱34,707.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
