I. Situation Overview

On 23 January 2024 at around 5:27 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bogasong, Libagon, Southern Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Bogasong, Libagon, Southern Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or six (6) persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Bogasong Hall in Libagon, Southern Leyte (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Bogasong, Libagon, Southern Leyte (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱52,568.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱17,861.50 from DSWD and ₱34,707.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
