I. Situation Overview

On 03 February 2024 at around 1:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Relocation Site Arcabalo, Brgy. Bolo, Roxas City, Capiz. The fire was declared out at around 2:25 PM.

A total of three (3) families or 13 persons are affected in Brgy. Bolo, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex A).

There are three (3) families or 13 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Bolo Covered Court in Brgy. Bolo, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex B).

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Bolo, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P21,258.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
