#### I. Situation Overview

On 08 February 2024 at around 1:45 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bololacao, New Lucena, Iloilo. The fire was declared out at around 3:00 PM.

A total of six (6) families or 29 persons are affected in Brgy. Bololacao, New Lucena, Iloilo (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

One (1) family or seven (7) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged in Brgy. Bololacao, New Lucena, Iloilo (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P42,660.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
