





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 21 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 February 2024 at around 11:35 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 4 Alae Creek, Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 12:06 AM on 08 February 2024.

One (1) family or five (5) persons were affected in Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}10,793.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, \$\mathbb{P}7,470.50\$ from \$\mathbb{D}\$SWD and \$\mathbb{P}3,323.00\$ from the \$\mathbb{Local Government Unit (LGU)}\$ (see Annex D).
