

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City as of 21 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 February 2024 at around 11:35 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 4 Alae Creek, Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 12:06 AM on 08 February 2024.

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** were affected in **Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Bugo, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,793.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱7,470.50** from **DSWD** and **₱3,323.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
