

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Burgos, Cabarroguis, Quirino as of 15 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2024 at around 7:52 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Burgos, Cabarroguis, Quirino. The fire was declared out at around 8:30 AM.

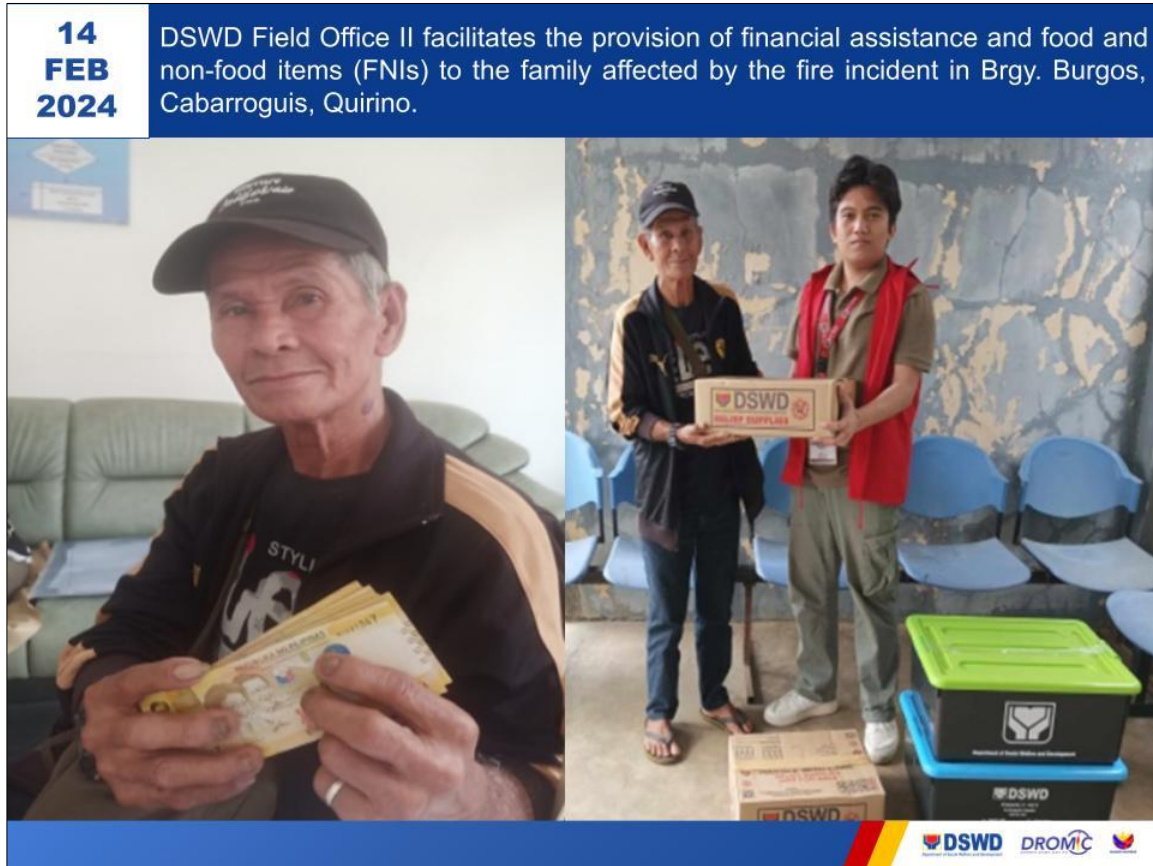
