





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City

as of 20 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 February 2024 at around 6:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Lower Puting-Bato, Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City.

The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals, wherein 17 residential houses were engulfed by the fire. In response, the Local Government Unit (LGU) of General Santos City, immediately extend food assistance, psychosocial intervention, and facilitated the relocation of the affected families.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XII, are actively engaged in the response operation, and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for any significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **25 families** or **103 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **25 families** or **103 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 17 houses were damaged; of which, 13 are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City (see Annex C).
