I. Situation Overview

On 31 January 2024 at around 4:43 AM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. Capoocan, Calbayog city, Samar.

A total of **40 families** or **158 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Capoocan, Calbayog City, Samar** (see Annex A).

A total of **40** houses were damaged; of which, **33** are totally damaged and **7** are partially damaged in Brgy. Capoocan, Calbayog City, Samar (see Annex C).
