I. Situation Overview

On 31 January 2024 at around 4:43 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Capoocan, Calbayog, Samar.

A total of **35 families** or **145 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Capoocan, Calbayog City** (see Annex A).

A total of **31 houses** were damaged; of which, **27** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Capoocan, Calbayog City** (see Annex B).
