

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Central, City of Mati, Davao Oriental

as of 21 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 February 2024 at around 8:45 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Duranta, Kalye Putol, Brgy. Central, City of Mati, Davao Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 10:39 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **49 families** or **170 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Central, City of Mati, Davao Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **49 families** or **170 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Central Evacuation Center** in **City of Mati, Davao Oriental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **37 houses** were damaged; of which, **30** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Central, City of Mati, Davao Oriental** (see Annex C).
