





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. East Timawa, Iloilo City

as of 24 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2024 at around 02:36 PM, a fire occurred in Brgy. East Timawa, Molo District in Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 03:04 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of two (2) families or 13 persons are affected in Brgy. East Timawa, Iloilo City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy, East Timawa, Iloilo City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}24,219.05\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}17,314.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}6,905.05\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
