I. Situation Overview

On 19 February at around 11:55 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Himalandrog, Calbayog City, Western Samar. The fire was declared out at around 2:00 AM on 20 February 2024.

1. Standby Funds

20 February 2024	 DSWD FO VIII closely coordinate with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Calbayog City for any significant disaster response updates and possible relief augmentation requests. DSWD FO VIII closely coordinates with the City Social Welfare Development Office (CSWDO) of Calbayog City on the number of displaced population. The CSWDO is conducting validation and assessment on the breakdown of the displaced families and persons.

The Disaster Response Operations Management, Information and Communication (DROMIC) Division of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO VIII for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
