I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024 at around 10:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 13-Carcon Village, Brgy. Lagao, General Santos City.

There are **20 families** or **81 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Carcon Village Multipurpose Hall** in **Brgy. Lagao, General Santos City** (see Annex B).

A total of **20 houses** were damaged; of which, **19** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lagao, General Santos City** (see Annex D).
