as of 08 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 January 2024 at around 3AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 4, Brgy. Liwayway, Diffun, Quirino. The fire was declared out at around 7AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or seven (7) persons are affected in Brgy. Liwayway, Diffun, Quirino (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **seven (7) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Liwayway, Diffun, Quirino** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱16,693.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱16,043.00 from DSWD and ₱650.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
