I. Situation Overview

On 12 February 2024 at around 10 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Malhacan, Meycauayan City, Bulacan.

A total of **29 families** or **106 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Malhacan, Meycauayan City, Bulacan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **29 families** or **106 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Meycauayan City, Bulacan** (see Annex B).

A total of **12 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Malhacan, Meycauayan City, Bulacan** (see Annex C).
