

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mambagaton, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental

as of 03 February 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 January 2024 at around 5:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mambagaton, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental, and was declared fire out at 6:35 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI and the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Himamaylan City, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

**One (1) family** or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mambagaton, Himamaylan City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **four (4) persons** are temporary staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was totally damaged in **Brgy. Mambagaton, Himamaylan City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱18,586.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of **₱8,586.00** from **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
