





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Niog, Bacoor City, Cavite

as of 20 February 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 17 February 2024 at around 4:20 PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Niog, Bacoor, Cavite, and was declared fire out at around 5:27 PM.

The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals, wherein 20 residential houses were razed to the ground. In response, the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Bacoor City, immediately extend food assistance, psychosocial intervention, and started facilitating the relocation of the affected families.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region CALABARZON, are actively engaged in the response operation, and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for any significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **91 families** or **319 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Niog, Bacoor City, Cavite** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

## a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **39 families** or **103 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Niog Covered Court in **Brgy. Niog, Bacoor City, Cavite** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **52 families** or **216 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

## c. Total Displaced Population

There are 91 families or 319 persons displaced in Brgy. Niog, Bacoor City, Cavite (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **20 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Niog**, **Bacoor City**, **Cavite** (see Annex E).







## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱18,720.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex F).
