## I. Situation Overview

On 13 February 2024 at around 1:57 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Basbas, Brgy. Pagsabungan, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 2:32 PM.

There are **28 families** or **116 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy**. **Pagsabungan Gymnasium**, **Mandaue City**, **Cebu** (see Annex B).

A total of 21 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Pagsabungan, Mandaue City, Cebu (see Annex C).
