





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pahina Central, Cebu City

as of 15 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 February 2024 at around 12:42 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pahina Central, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 1:55 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **66 families** or **293 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pahina Central**, **Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 66 families or 293 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Regino Elementary School in Brgy. Pahina Central, Cebu City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 36 houses were damaged; of which, 35 are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Pahina Central, Cebu City (see Annex C).
