I. Situation Overview

On 11 February 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 5, Brgy. Perpetual Help, Iriga City, Camarines Sur.

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Perpetual Help, Iriga City, Camarines Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Perpetual Help, Iriga City, Camarines Sur** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,596.66** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
