



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pilar Village, Las Piñas City

as of 22 February 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 22 February 2024 at around 8:31 AM, a fire incident occurred at Maligaya Compound, Brgy Pilar Village, Las Piñas City. The fire was declared out at around 9:44 AM.

A total of **133 families** or **532 persons** are affected in **Brgy Pilar Village**, Las Piñas City (see Annex A).

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **133 families** or **532 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **50 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pilar Village**, **Las Piñas City** (see Annex C).
