



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan

as of 16 February 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 12 February 2024 at around 3:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at P. Moran West Street, Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan.

## **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **18 families** or **69 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **45 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Lingayen Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan** (see Annex B).

- b. Outside Evacuation Center There are five (5) families or 20 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population There are 15 families or 65 persons displaced in Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12** houses were damaged; of which, **10** are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Lingayen, Pangasinan (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱113,248.80 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱106,948.80 from DSWD and ₱6,300.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
