I. Situation Overview

On 27 January 2024 at around 1:15 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pogo Chico, Dagupan City, Pangasinan.

A total of **14 families** or **51 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pogo Chico, Dagupan City, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **14 families** or **51 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Pogo Chico, Dagupan City, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).
