



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pulvorista, Kawit, Cavite

as of 08 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 February 2024 at around 12:37 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pulvorista, Kawit, Cavite. Initial investigation showed that fire apparently started from unattended candle and rapidly spread to nearby houses mostly made of light materials. The fire was contained at around 2:15 AM.

c. Other Activities

08 February 2024	 DSWD FO CALABARZON, through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) and Crisis Intervention Section (CIS), closely monitors the situation and prepares for the possible provision of assistance to the affected families and individuals. DSWD FO CALABARZON maintains close coordination with the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) of the Provincial Government of Cavite and the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of the LGU of Kawit, Cavite for any significant updates relative to the fire incident. The Rapid Assessment Team of DSWD FO CALABARZON Provincial QRT in Cavite was advised to be on standby for possible deployment.
