





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan

as of 24 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 February 2024 at around 3:59 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Santan, Sitio Kasaysayan, Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 12 families or 45 persons are affected in Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are eight (8) families or 31 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Municipal Sub-Office of Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 12 families or 45 persons displaced in Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of nine (9) houses were totally damaged (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}77,267.40\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}69,167.40\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}8,100.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).
