
DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan as of 24 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 February 2024 at around 3:59 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Santan, Sitio Kasaysayan, Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **12 families** or **45 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **31 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Municipal Sub-Office** of **Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **12 families** or **45 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were **totally damaged** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱77,267.40** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱69,167.40** from **DSWD** and **₱8,100.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
