





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Antonio, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental

as of 03 February 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 01 February 2024 at around 3:10 PM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. San Antonio, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental, and was declared fire out at around 5:05 PM.

In response to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI together with the LGU of Himamaylan City, promptly provided intervention to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals through the provision of relief assistance.

A total of five (5) families or 17 persons are affected in Brgy. San Antonio, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **five (5) families** or **17 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

Five (5) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. San Antonio, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}92,930.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of \$\mathbb{P}42,930.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}50,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
