I. Situation Overview

On 14 February 2024 at around 10:05 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City.

A total of 19 families or 60 persons are affected in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 19 families or 60 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Rural Health Center in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 10 houses were damaged; of which, seven (7) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P13,250.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
