I. Situation Overview

On 14 February 2024 at around 10:05 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City.

A total of **19 families** or **60 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

There are **19 families** or **60 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Rural Health Center** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱13,250.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
