

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Roque, Marikina City as of 26 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 February 2024 at around 5:21 PM, a fire incident occurred at Shoe Avenue Ext., Brgy. San Roque, Marikina City. The fire was declared out at around 5:56 PM.

A total of **three (3) families** or **11 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Roque, Marikina City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **11 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. San Roque, Marikina City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,056.95** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
