

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City as of 15 February 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 11 February 2024 at around 7:20 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Providence, Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City. The fire was declared out at around 9:25 AM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **nine (9) families** or **43 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **21 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Purok Providence Chapel** in **Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱75,992.02** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
