





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City

as of 15 February 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 11 February 2024 at around 7:20 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Providence, Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City. The fire was declared out at around 9:25 AM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of nine (9) families or 43 persons are affected in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are four (4) families or 21 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Purok Providence Chapel in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Sum-ag, Bacolod City (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P75,992.02** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
