I. Situation Overview

On 05 February 2024 at around 9:15 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tisa, Cebu City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 9:50 AM.

A total of **22 families** or **95 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tisa, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 22 families or 95 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Tisa National High School in Brgy. Tisa, Cebu City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 16 houses were damaged; of which, 14 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Tisa, Cebu City (see Annex C).
