I. Situation Overview

On 18 February 2024 at around 7:51 AM, a fire incident occurred at Angel Santos St., Brgy. Tumana, Marikina City. The fire was declared out at around 9:05 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **50 families** or **213 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tumana**, **Marikina City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **50 families** or **213 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Angel Santos Covered Court** in **Brgy. Tumana, Marikina City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 30 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Tumana, Marikina City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P33,494.50** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families and individuals (see Annex E).
