

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental

as of 20 February 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 19 February 2024 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 5:25 PM.

A total of **16 families** or **54 persons** are affected in **Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **34 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. V (Poblacion) Multipurpose Hall** in **Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. V (Poblacion), Victorias City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).
