#### I. Situation Overview

On 23 February 2024 at around 11:13 PM, a fire incident occurred at Backside St., Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 2:06 AM.

A total of 119 families or 459 persons are affected in Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City (see Annex A).

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 119 families or 459 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Brgy. Vergara Covered Court in Mandaluyong City (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **57 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Vergara, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex C).
