



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

as of 08 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 February 2024 at around 2:29 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Bagong Silang, Puerto Princesa City that also affected the nearby Brgy. Pagkakaisa. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) MIMAROPA

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **435 families** or **1,946 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **435 families** or **1,946 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Pilot Elementary School** in **Brgy. Pagkakaibigan**, **Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,964,298.69** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
