

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Mw 5.8 Earthquake Incident in Las Nieves, Agusan del Norte as of 11 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 February 2024 at 11:22 AM, a 5.8-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Las Nieves, Agusan del Norte (08.70°N, 125.57°E - 006 km S 46° W) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus at 25 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.
