I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 1:46 PM, a vehicular incident occurred in Sitio Tubod in Brgy. Bulwang, Mabinay, Negros Oriental that resulted in several casualties.

A total of **17 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bulwang** in **Mabinay, Negros Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱447,272.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected persons; of which, **₱187,272.00** from **DSWD** and **₱260,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
