

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol as of 01 March 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 February 2024 at around 6:50 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and alleged members of the Communist Terrorists Group (CTG) that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **250 families** or **770 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **44 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Campagao Covered Court** in **Bilar, Bohol** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **242 families** or **726 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **250 families** or **770 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol** (see Annex E).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱248,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱103,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱145,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
