



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Dados, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte

as of 20 February 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 February 2024 at around 7:20 PM, an armed conflict transpired between two (2) unidentified armed groups in Brgy. Dados, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

### **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **770 families** or **3,850 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dados, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **770 families** or **3,850 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱512,050.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
