




DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA)

as of 31 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024, the Municipalities of Compostela, Monkayo, and New Bataan in Davao de Oro and the Municipalities of Bunawan and Rosario in Agusan del Sur experienced the effects of the trough of LPA.

Issued on 31 January 2024 at 4PM, Caraga, Davao Region, and SOCCSKSARGEN are experiencing cloudy skies with scattered to widespread rains and thunderstorms caused by the trough of LPA, which may bring possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy to at times intense rain. Central Visayas, Southern Leyte, and the rest of Mindanao on the other hand are experiencing cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms caused by the trough of LPA, which may bring possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to and thunderstorms caused by the trough of LPA, which may bring possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **9,786 families** or **37,684 persons** are affected in **66 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex A).









III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,133 families** or **3,769 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **47 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **1,597 families** or **6,495 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **2,730 families** or **10,264 persons** displaced in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Caraga (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱489,096.00** worth of assistance were provided by the **LGU** to the affected families (see Table H).

1. Standby Funds

- 144,524 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and Caraga.
- 1,099,028 FFPs in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of the Trough of LPA through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱1.54 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO warehouses.
