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## **DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident at Iriga City Public Market in Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur**

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 02 February 2024 at around 12:17 AM, a fire incident occurred at a Public Market in Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur. The fire was declared out at around 2:47 AM.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **90 stall owners** and **vendors** are affected in **Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur**; of which, **three (3) families** or **18 persons** have their stalls as their own houses (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **two (2) families** or **15 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. San Francisco Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

**One (1) family** or **three (3) persons** are temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

A total of **three (3) families** or **18 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **three (3) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur** (see Annex E).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱2,773,091.70** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
