





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident at Iriga City Public Market in Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur

as of 07 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 February 2024 at around 12:17 AM, a fire incident occurred at a Public Market in Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur. The fire was declared out at around 2:47 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 90 stall owners and vendors are affected in Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur; of which, three (3) families or 18 persons have their stalls as their own houses (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **two (2) families** or **15 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. San Francisco Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or three (3) persons are temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of three (3) families or 18 persons were displaced in Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. San Francisco, Iriga City, Camarines Sur (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱2,773,091.70 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
