





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City

as of 19 February 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 February 2023 at around 11:26 AM, a fire incident occurred at Alonzo cor. Fugoso St., Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City, and was declared fire out at around 12:41 PM.

The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals, wherein 79 residential structures were engulfed by the fire. Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, is actively engaged in the response operation, and continuously coordinating with the Manila Department of Social Welfare as to any significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 124 families or 428 persons are affected in Brgy. 330, Sta. Cruz, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are 124 families or 428 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **79 houses** were damaged; of which, **61** are **totally damaged** and **18** are **partially damaged** in in **Brgy. 330**, **Sta. Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex C).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱109.15 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.55 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 147,472 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 108,238 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 39,234 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 36,655 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱590.65 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

b. Other Activities
