I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 1:26 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 52, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 2:44 PM.

A total of **95 families** or **303 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 52, Tondo** in **Manila City** (see Annex A).

A total of **22 houses** were totally damaged in **Brgy. 52, Tondo** in **Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱496,823.25** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
